ROMA

is the capital and largest city of Italy and of the Lazio region. It's the famed city of the Roman Empire, the Seven Hills, *La Dolce Vita* (the sweet life), the Vatican City and *the Colosseo*. Rome, as a millenium-long centre of power, culture and religion, having been the centre of one of the globe's greatest civilizations ever, has exerted a huge influence over the world in its c. 2500 years of existence.

The Historic Centre of the city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. With wonderful palaces, millenium-old churches and basilicas, grand romantic ruins, opulent monuments, ornate statues and graceful fountains, Rome has an immensely rich historical heritage and cosmopolitan atmosphere, making it one of Europe's and the world's most visited, famous, influential and beautiful capitals. Rome has a nightlife scene and is also seen as a shopping heaven, being regarded as one of the fashion capitals of the world (some of Italy's oldest jewellery and clothing establishments were founded in the city).

Where many of the hotels are, as well as shopping along the Via Veneto; home to the Quirinale, Trevi fountain, Barberini, Castro Pretorio, and Repubblica areas. The center of the Roman Renaissance period, with beautiful squares, cathedrals, the Pantheon, and plenty of laid-back dining; includes the Piazza Navona , Campo de' Fiori.

VITERBO

As a settlement Viterbo dates back to Etruscan times. Between around 1100 and 1300, it was one of the most important cities in Europe. By the 13th Century it had 50 castles under its control. It was the place where Popes took refuge when driven out of Rome and for several decades was the seat of the Papacy. It was the scene of battles between potential invaders of Rome and papal armies.

Last century it was damaged by appalling Fascist-era town planning and then by Allied bombs.

These days its population is about the same as it was in the 13th Century, at around 60,000. Apart from its tradition its main claim to fame now is that Italy's gold reserves are held there.

You can visit its beautiful Etruscan province for a romantic honeymoon with a classic car during a tour too.

BRACCIANO

In the province of Rome, situated on a high hill the town of Bracciano, in a dominant position on Lake Bracciano or Sabatino Lake. According to the legend below the lake would be submerged part of the city, and the remaining part would be called out by the Bracciano lake by virtue of the form assumed.

Nature trails and sailing and motorboat races in Bracciano Lake, which with its 57 square kilometers, is the second largest lake in Lazio. Of volcanic origin, is none other than the crater of an extinct volcano which over the centuries has been filled with water. All around you can admire beautiful landscape and little Roman and Etruscan little towns.

GAETA

Ancient city, according to legend, its name comes from the nurse of Enea. Gaeta is a peninsula beautifully situated on the sea.

It's also a city full of history and glorious maritime republic independent duchy, then incorporated in the Bourbon Kingdom of which will be the last bastion before the unification of Italy. The Cave of Gold however, is the main feature of the fourteenth-century Church of the Annunciation. Inside, there is an important collection of ancient musical texts.

Gaeta extremely popular summertime destination because of its seven fabulous beaches. Locals and Italians from all over Italy flock to these beaches to soak up the sun and watch surfing events.

Whenever you visit, you'll find plenty to do, from hiking Monte Orlando to see ancient ruins to wandering the old, narrow streets to shop and eat.
